Notes:

- 1) Lord Nelson & Lady Emma Hamilton were present at Thomas Spencer & Mary Hever's wedding at Lord & Lady Hamilton's home in Palermo, Italy in 1799.
- 2) Lord Nelson & Lady Emma Hamilton were not present at the Baptism in Gotham, UK in 1804. Instead the Parish register included the name "Emma" above Thomas's name – see comment below.

Comment: It is believed the vicar(John Kirkby who was a Spencer family friend) included "Emma's name in the parish register" to certify who the real mother was – after being told that Horatio William was the illegitimate son of Lady Emma Hamilton & Lord Nelson by Thomas Spencer(Lord Nelson's Steward on the Foudroyant in 1799-1800).

Notes:

- 3) It is believed that Lord Nelson & Lady Emma Hamilton's illegitimate son was conceived in June/July 1799 and born at sea - Feb/March 1800.
- 4) It is believed that Lord Nelson & Lady Emma Hamilton's illegitimate daughter was conceived in April 1800 and born - Jan 1801.
